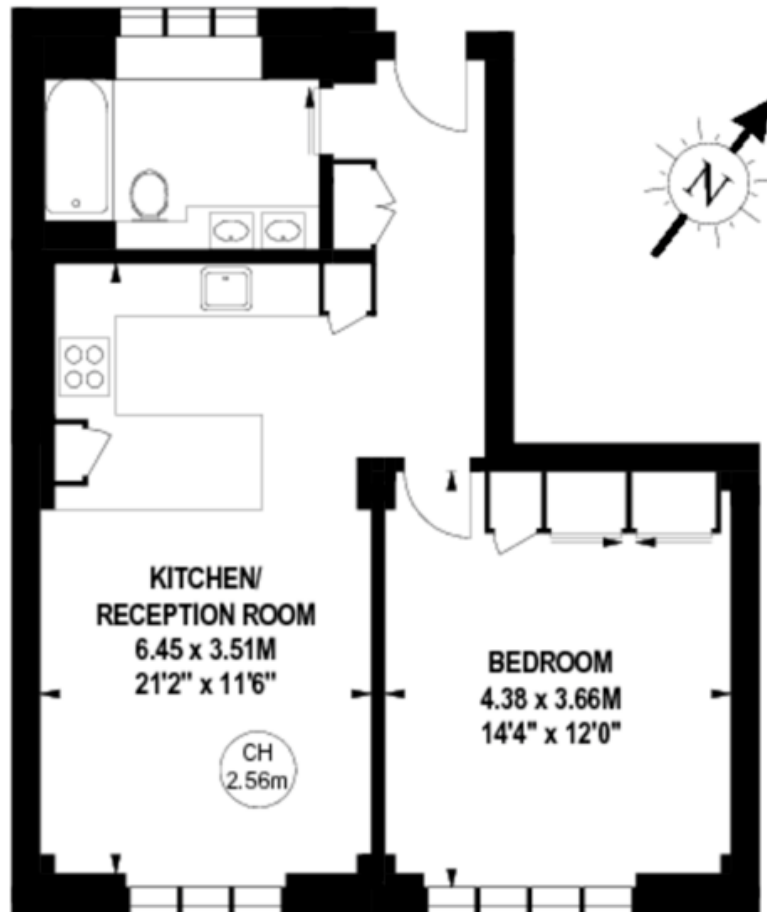

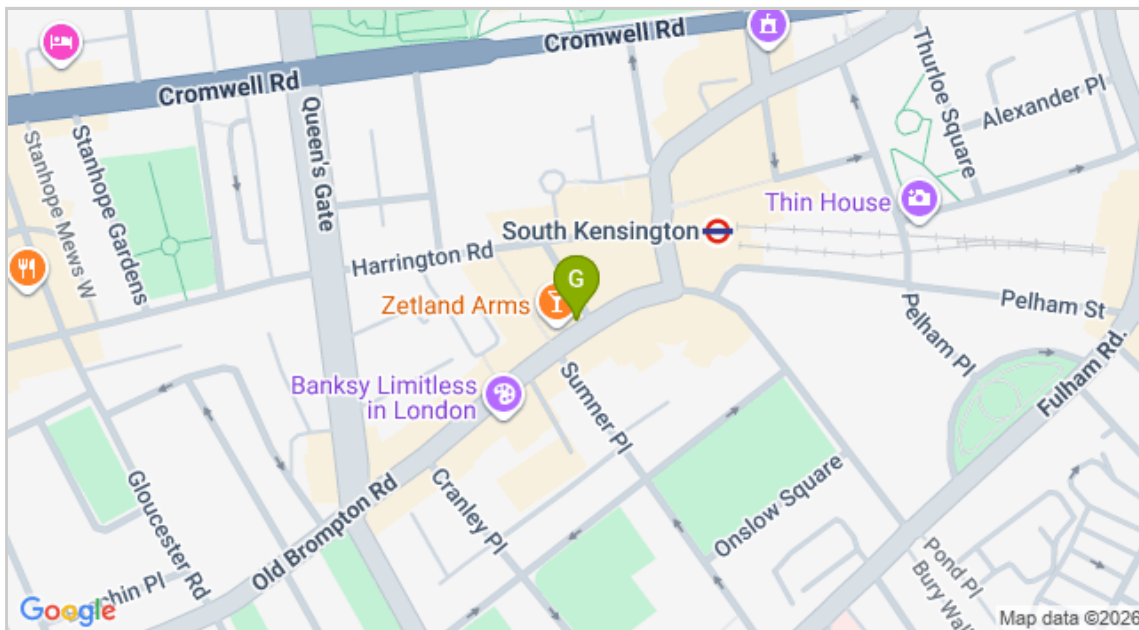
First Floor
